## DEPARTMENT 15 – HOME AND DAIRY PRODUCTS



### Section 1 Baked Products

#### SPECIAL INFORMATION:

1. Complete baked goods must be brought to the Fair. After judging, the fair may display only a portion of the product for the fair event.
2. Baked goods become the property of the fair. The exhibitor must have made all products.
3. Food products cannot be polluted with any substance or chemical that caused them to become poisonous or unfit to be used for food.
4. **All baked goods must be in clear ziplock plastic bags on foam or plastic plates;** except iced cakes or decorated cakes, which may be covered with plastic wrap, in a cardboard cake box or a plastic domed cake cover. Pie and cake carriers are available for exhibitors a week before the Fair – 6:00 to 7:00 PM.
5. No food requiring refrigeration will be accepted. Pies – NO cream or Custard pies will be accepted for exhibition. Pies should be in disposable aluminum pie plates.
6. All items entered in the “Other class” must be identified and named.

2. Creativity is essential to a varied competition. DO NOT LIMIT your entry to a "traditional" two-crust pie. We are looking for a variety of fillings in the pies.
3. The pie must include at least 60% apples in the filling.
4. Each fair will certify the winning apple pie baker and this person will be eligible to enter the state competition at the 2012 Farm Show.

NOTE: If an individual has already won 1<sup>st</sup> place at another fair in 2011 for this Blue Ribbon Apple Pie contest, that individual is now considered qualified through that fair to compete at the 2012 PA Farm Show and is no longer eligible to enter this contest at any upcoming fairs.

1. Open to any individual who is a Pennsylvania resident.
2. Entrants may NOT have won 1<sup>st</sup> place in this Angel Food Cake contest at any other fair in 2011.
3. Entry must be a cake made from scratch using "PEQAP" eggs.
4. Pennsylvania Quality Assured Program (PEQAP) eggs are requested to be used if at all possible.
5. Refrigeration is NOT available at the fair or the PA Farm Show. Entries that require refrigeration after baking must indicate so in the recipe. Those entering will not be sold, auctioned or otherwise distributed for consumption after judging for food safety reason.
6. Cake entry must be submitted for judging on cardboard.
7. Recipe(s) listing the ingredients and the preparation instructions must be submitted with the entry (printed on one side of an 8 ½ x 11" size paper). Entrants name, address and phone number must be printed on the back of all papers.
