



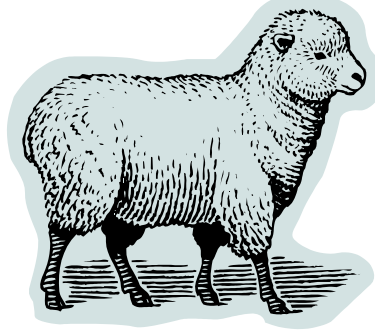

DEPARTMENT 4 – SHEEP



SPECIAL INFORMATION:

1. General Rules and Health Rules (refer to table of contents) also apply. Applications must be received three weeks prior to the fair and mailed to the address indicated in the General Rules. Exhibitors must have all animals on the fairgrounds at the appointed time-THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS.
2. Any animal of unthrifty nature, unsuitable condition, or which cannot be satisfactorily handled under show conditions must be removed from the fairgrounds. The Sheep Superintendent reserves the right to reject any animals, which in his judgement is not suitable for exhibition. Sheep infected with ticks, showing an unthrifty condition; or not properly cleaned for the show will be rejected.
3. Health certificates and registration papers must accompany all animals upon entry to the fairgrounds as well as on show days.
4. The exhibitor is defined as the owner or the name as it exactly appears on the registration papers.
5. All breeding animals must be registered with an association. Entry forms for animals with registration pending will be accepted; however, certificate indicating such is required on arrival at the fair.
6. Lambs shown in breeding classes cannot be shown in market classes and vice-versa.
7. If an exhibitor is personally unable to tend to his animals during the fair, he must inform the Superintendent of the fair and submit the name of the person whom shall be responsible in his absence, Failure to do so will forfeit all or part of the premiums and could result in removal of the exhibit entries from the fair.

8. If it is the opinion of the judge that an animal is not deserving of an award, it will be placed at the discretion of the judge, The judge's decision is final.
9. The Sheep Superintendent will appoint open and youth committees to enforce rules and settle disputes, which might arise.
10. A Pen of Lambs consists of two ram lambs and two ewe lambs, all owned by one exhibitor.
11. A Flock consists of one ram, any age; two ewes, one year and under two years (yearling); and two ewes under one year (lambs). All must be owned by the exhibitor.
12. Breeders Young Flock consists of one ram lamb and two ewe lambs; all bred and owned by the exhibitor.
13. A Get of Sire shall consist of four breeding animals, any age or sex and the get of one sire. Get need not be owned by the exhibitor.
14. Ewe and Offspring consist of ewe and lamb or lambs of one lambing.
15. Exhibitor must agree with SHOW RING CODE OF ETHICS (refer to table of contents) and sign the verification on the reverse side of entry form.
16. All sheep sheared in back of barn, not in aisles. No shearing market animals after weight in.
