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DEPARTMENT 6 – GOATS



SPECIAL INFORMATION:

1. General Rules and Health Rules also apply. Application must be received three weeks prior to the fair and mailed to the address indicated in the General Rules. Exhibitors must have all animals on the fairgrounds at the appointed time-THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS.
2. Any animal of unthrifty nature, unsuitable condition, or which cannot be satisfactorily handled under show conditions must be removed from the fairgrounds.
3. Official Health Certificate (AAI-13) issued by the Bureau of Animal Industry must accompany all goats for show. To be eligible for the show season, the animal must be tested for Brucellosis and Tuberculosis after April 1, unless from a Certified and Accredited herd.
4. If it is the opinion of the judge that an animal is not deserving of an award, it will be placed at the discretion of the judge. The judge decision is final.
5. Only breeds recognized by the American Dairy Goat Association will be accepted.
6. Get of Sire shall consist of 3 doe from a particular sire.
7. Produce of Dam shall consist of 2 doe, the produce of one dam.
8. Exhibitor must agree with SHOW RING CODE OF ETHICS and sign the verification on the reverse side of the entry form.

Section 2 – Open Meat Goats

1. A total of two (2) meat goats can be entered. They must be pre-registered by May 31st, tagged, weighed, vet checked, etc. upon entry. Only two (2) meat goats per person can be entered and shown. For more information or assistance contact: Joann Carney at 785-2316. Only 4H & Youth entries may be sold at Southern Wayne Jr. Livestock Sale.
2. A minimum weight of 60 pounds, maximum of 110 pounds is requested.
3. All entries for Market sale must be from Pike, Wayne or Lackawanna County.
4. Meat goats shall be free of any infections and/or transmittable diseases. A health certificate and proof of all required testing must be provided before the animal enters the fair grounds.
5. All meat goats should be Boer, Boer X or any acceptable meat goat cross. Males must be castrated and should be de-horned for the safety of the exhibitor.
6. SLICK SHEARING OF MEAT GOATS IS ENCOURAGED, AT LEAST 5 DAYS BEFORE SHOWING, BUT CANNOT BE DONE AFTER WEIGH-IN.
